

# Quo Vadis, color topo in English 5.9, A4/A4+

El Capitan - Quo Vadis, VI, 5.9+, A4/A4+  
Jacek Czyz solo, Oct - Nov 2002

30 days on the wall, 26 climbing, 23 nights. Start on Oct 8th, continuous push 19th-26th, next one on Nov 1st-6th stopped by bad weather. Final push from the 12th, top on Nov 20th.

Descent by rappel down the ascent route and Muir Wall Nov. 21-22.

Route named after a famous novel by Henryk Sienkiewicz (published 1896, Nobel Prize 1905).

All belay stances: 2-3 bolts 3/8"

Only stance 10th: 1 bolt and cams 1/2-1"

33 new belay bolts + 20 existing

14 lead bolts 3/8" + 6 existing

51 rivets (most S55/16", 6AL), 24 exist.

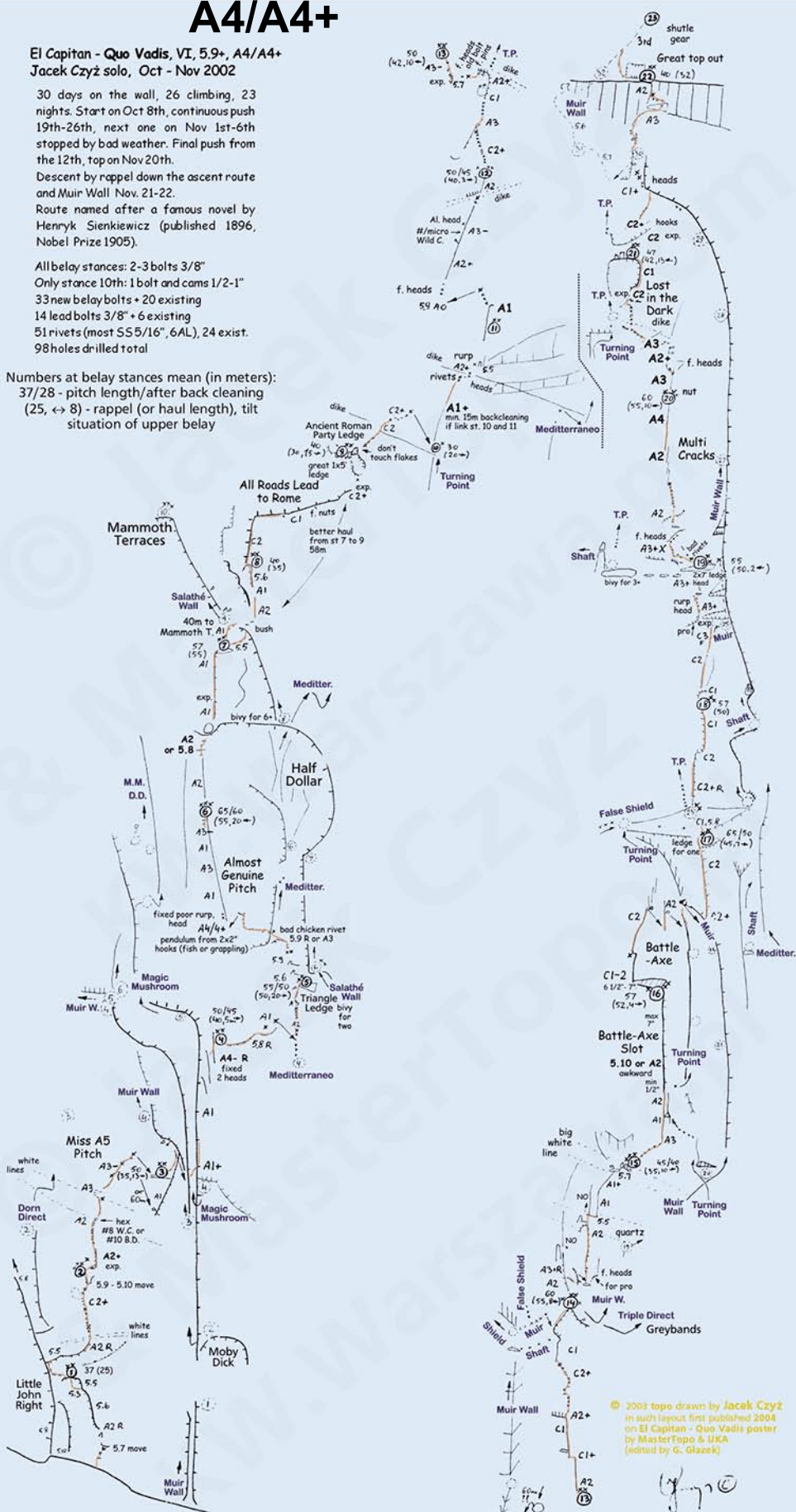
98 holes drilled total

Numbers at belay stances mean (in meters):

37/28 - pitch length/after back cleaning

(25, ↔ 8) - rappel (or haul length), tilt
